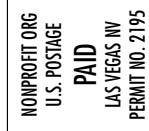


Race the Bed to Read!

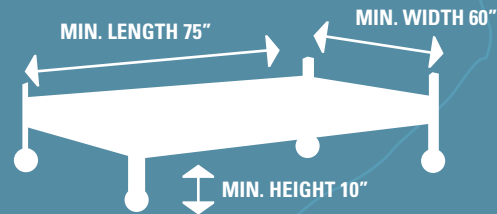

Team Information and Safety

- Race teams must consist of 5 people and 1 member of the team must ride in the bed at all times while the other 4 push the bed
- All participants must be 18 years of age
- Safety gear such as helmets, elbow pads, knee pads are recommended
- Bed race teams are responsible for insuring the safe construction and operation of their beds (unsafe beds jeopardize not only the safety of team members, but also the safety of competitors and spectators)
- Team members can not interfere with their opponents in any way
- The entrance fee and registration form must be turned in prior to race day
- All participants must sign a waiver on the day of the event prior to race time at check-in

“Race The Bed” Bed Building Guidelines and Road Rules

- Teams can create their own bed frames or one will be provided for them
- Teams can retain their own mattresses or one will be provided for them
- Mattress must be a standard double size mattress: innerspring, minimum size 54\" wide by 75\" long
- The height of the bed should be 10\" from the ground and allow for stability against overturning
- 4 wheels are mandatory and must have a maximum diameter of no more than 36\"
- Wheels must be in contact with the road at all times
- No motorized mechanisms of any kind (i.e. engines, brakes, etc.) are allowed
- Push bars are allowed but cannot exceed the total width of 96\"
- Decorated beds are encouraged, but no sharp or protruding edges or objects are allowed
- In order to qualify for finishing the race, at least 4 of the 5 team members must cross the finish line in contact with the bed and 3 members must also be in contact with the ground when crossing the finish line
- Team name should be displayed and securely fastened on the bed

The object is to create a bed that can be easily maneuvered and be sturdy enough to hold an individual as you push the bed to the finish line.

Remember safety should be the highest priority during assembly and while racing.
